6.3.32 Conservation awareness material/Awareness Program

Majority of the people around the globe are interested in taking care of the natural environment, but they have no formal education and awareness to justify as why to take care of the nature and natural resources or why they should feel responsible for it. The confusion is a great problem not only for contemporary society but for future generations as well. Thus, proper education and awareness about the natural environment is important to address the current environmental issues.

Environmental education is aimed at producing a citizenry that is knowledgeable concerning the biophysical environment and its associated problems, aware of how to help solve these problems, and motivated to work toward their solution. Thus, for promoting environmental education, a variety of strategies and approaches have to be adopted for creating awareness among the general public about the environmental issues in general and wildlife conservation issues in particular. For this purpose, a comprehensive education and awareness plan will be prepared by DFO Wildlife Extension within the first three months and the same will be approved by PMU for its formal implementation through DFO Extension and other field officers of the Department. For this purpose sum of Rs 10.500 Million has been set-aside for the said activity.

6.3.33 Project Internees

In order to streamline the processes and devise a uniform policy for engagement of internees in different development projects, the Competent Authority is pleased to approve the Provincial Internship Policy for all Administrative Departments, attached formations and Government owned autonomous/semi-autonomous organization with immediate effect. The policy shall be followed in letter and spirit by all concerned departments, district governments and autonomous bodies. For this purpose four internees have been inducted in the subject PC-I and amount of Rs 4.00 Million has been earmarked in the revised PC-I
