

CONSOLIDATED MEASURES FOR RAMAZAN
(from Pre-Ramazan Preparations to Operational Enforcement)

1. Enforcement of Notified Prices

Responsibility: All Deputy Commissioners

- Enforce prices finalized pre-Ramazan.
- Daily comparison of market vs notified rates.
- Immediate action against overpricing.
- Weekly deviation review.

2. Operation of Price Monitoring Camps / Desks

Responsibility: All Deputy Commissioners

- Camps operational 0800 hrs till Iftar.
- On-spot complaint resolution.
- Daily reporting of complaints received, resolved, and action taken.
- Immediate linkage with Price Control Magistrates.

3. Field Inspections by Price Monitoring Teams

Responsibility: All Deputy Commissioners

- Daily surprise inspections and test purchases.
- Verification of price list display.
- Submission of daily inspection logs.
- Visible identification of teams during field duty.

4. Sabzi / Fruit Mandi Auction Control

Responsibility: All Deputy Commissioners, Agriculture & Food Departments

- Mandatory presence of Magistrate and departmental representative during auctions.
- Same-day upload of signed wholesale price lists.
- Monitoring wholesale-retail price spread.
- Immediate action against manipulation or collusion.

5. Continuous Quality Assurance (Milk, Food & Weights)

Responsibility: All Deputy Commissioners, Halal Food Authority, Industries Department

- Daily milk adulteration testing.
- Inspection of Sehri and Iftar food items.
- Enforcement of Weights & Measures compliance.
- Sealing of substandard outlets and action against violators.

6. Anti-Hoarding Operations

Responsibility: All Deputy Commissioners, Special Branch, Police, Food Department

- Surprise warehouse inspections and stock verification.
- Confiscation and legal action where required.
- Monitoring abnormal price spikes.
- Special Branch to submit independent reporting and pointation on hoarding, cartelization, and artificial shortages.
- Daily anti-hoarding enforcement report.

7. Supply & Shortage Assessment

Responsibility: Food Department, All Deputy Commissioners, Special Branch

- Continuous assessment of essential commodity availability.
- Monitoring wheat and flour stock position.
- Early warning of potential shortages.
- Recommend and implement remedial measures including inter-district coordination or stock release.
- Monday, Wednesday, Friday supply position report during Ramazan.

8. Wheat & Wheat Flour Quality Control

Responsibility: Food Department, All Deputy Commissioners

- Regular inspection and sampling of wheat and flour.
- Monitoring quality of subsidized stocks.
- Laboratory testing where required.
- Immediate corrective measures in case of substandard quality.

9. Waste Management & Sanitation

Responsibility: All Deputy Commissioners, Local Government Department

- Extended cleaning shifts before Iftar.
- Priority sanitation near mosques and Dastarkhwans.
- Daily waste-lifting performance reporting.

10. Traffic & Crowd Management

Responsibility: District Police, Traffic Police, All Deputy Commissioners

- Enhanced traffic deployment before Iftar peak hours.
- Active management of identified choke points.
- Temporary parking arrangements operational.
- Police to ensure smooth mobility in major bazaars and commercial areas.

11. Action Against Beggar Mafia

Responsibility: District Police, All Deputy Commissioners

- Targeted operations against organized begging networks.
- Identification of rackets exploiting minors or vulnerable persons.
- Enforcement under relevant laws to maintain public order.

12. Trader Compliance Monitoring

Responsibility: All Deputy Commissioners

- Monitor compliance with concessional pricing commitments made pre-Ramazan.
- Weekly engagement with trader associations.

13. Complaint Redress Mechanism (Operational)

Responsibility: PMRU, CM Office, All Deputy Commissioners

- Daily consolidation of complaints via Ikhtiar Awam Ka App, WhatsApp, Control Rooms, and Camps.
- Resolution within defined timelines.
- Escalation of unresolved cases.

14. Standardized Price List Enforcement

Responsibility: All Deputy Commissioners

- Daily verification of conspicuous price list display.

- Removal of non-compliant displays.
- Immediate enforcement action where absent.

15. Deployment of Additional Price Control Magistrates

Responsibility: Home Department, Food Department, All Deputy Commissioners

- Home Department to notify additional Magistrates including:
 - Deputy Directors Food
 - District Food Controllers (DFCs)
 - Additional Deputy Commissioners (ADCs)
 - Tehsildars
 - Naib Tehsildars (where required)
 - TMOs (where notified)
- Ensure field presence during peak hours (0800–1100 and 1630–Iftar).
- Clear duty rosters circulated publicly.
- Daily enforcement summary.

16. Dual Price Monitoring Mechanism

Responsibility: PMRU, EMA, All Deputy Commissioners

- EMA to independently collect two daily sample prices per Tehsil (HQ + peripheral market).
- Compare EMA data with district submissions.
- Identify abnormal upward variation.

17. Evening Review at PMRU (Zoom)

Responsibility: PMRU, All Deputy Commissioners, Food Department

- Evening review meeting.
- Districts showing abnormal upward variation to provide explanation.
- Food Department to present supply-side assessment where relevant.
- Remedial measures to be decided and recorded.
- Persistent deviations to be escalated.

18. Ramazan Dastarkhwans

Responsibility: Social Welfare Department, All Deputy Commissioners

- Daily supervision and hygiene inspection (Dastarkhwans should be through **philanthropists**).
- Oversight of Sehri and Iftar arrangements in Sarais and Panagahs.
- Ensure cleanliness and orderly management.

19. Utility Coordination (Water & Gas)

Responsibility: Energy & Power Department, All Deputy Commissioners

- Ensure uninterrupted water supply before Sehri and peak Iftar hours.
- Coordinate with SNGPL for gas pressure management.
- Nominate district focal persons for escalation.
- Include utility status in daily review.

20. Monitoring of Essential Medicines

Responsibility: Health Department

- Inspection of pharmacies for overcharging on essential medicines.

- Ensure availability of emergency medical facilities near major markets.
- Immediate action against profiteering.

21. Regulation of Iftar & Bakery Items

Responsibility: All Deputy Commissioners, Food Department

- Include commonly consumed Iftar items under monitoring.
- Surprise checks for overpricing and underweight selling.
- Enforce display of price and weight for packaged Iftar deals.

22. Monitoring of Peripheral & Rural Markets

Responsibility: All Deputy Commissioners, Commissioners

- Ensure inspection coverage extends beyond Tehsil HQ markets.
- Rotational surprise visits to rural and peripheral bazaars.
- Include peripheral markets in daily monitoring samples.

23. Meat Pricing & Slaughterhouse Compliance

Responsibility: All Deputy Commissioners, Local Government Department, Livestock Department

- Daily monitoring of beef and mutton prices.
- Verification of live animal to retail price spread.
- Ensure only functional slaughterhouses are used.
- Ensure veterinary inspection presence.

24. Inter-District & Inter-Provincial Supply Monitoring

Responsibility: Food Department, All Deputy Commissioners, Border District Administrations

- Monitor inflow of milk, vegetables, flour, and essential commodities.
- Immediate coordination in case of supply disruption or abnormal price movement.
- Maintain communication between bordering districts.

25. Pre-Eid Surge Management (Last 5 Days of Ramazan)

Responsibility: All Deputy Commissioners, Police, Rescue 1122, Local Government Department

- Activate enhanced crowd and traffic management plan.
- Monitor night bazaars.
- Additional deployment in commercial hubs after Tarawih.
- Emergency and medical readiness during peak shopping days.
